Greetings from the Coast of SC!

In March, Hal Fair, David Watson, 11 MUSC students and I comprised the SC delegation for the ADA and ADPAC's Lobby Day in Washington, DC. It was the first in person Lobby Day since 2019. Typically, the meeting brings about 1500 dentists and students together; however, this year was scaled down with about 400 in attendance. Yet even with the smaller numbers, the energy of the group was palpable. Fresh off the heels of the McCarron/Ferguson victory, we were eager to hit the Hill in hopes of making positive changes for our profession.

The event began with a Sunday evening reception hosted by ADPAC. The reception was a great place to meet dentists from all over the country. Our delegation was fortunate to meet Dr. Cesar Sabates the current ADA President, and Dr. George Shepley, the ADA President Elect. Following the reception, the students invited me to attend an ASDA party at a local board game bar. Spending time with the students was inspirational. They are an impressive group of young adults who are enthusiastic and willing to be involved.

When I was in dental school, it was difficult to get approval to leave the school/miss clinics for any circumstance. It's great that Dean Huja allows the students to participate in Lobby Day, giving them the opportunity to explore dentistry outside of the walls of MUSC, gaining different perspectives, and seeing how the political process works. Our group consisted of 5 D1 students- Johnny Lopiano, Landon Patterson, Aparna Mahendranath, Natalie Benkandil, and Bailey Lockwood; 5 D3 students- George Foster, Bradley Sanders, Katie Flynn, Mackenzie Long, and Sammy Huynh, who is the national Vice President of ASDA; and their fearless leader, D4 student Blakely McCormick. Blakely has been involved in Lobby Day for her entire student career. Upon graduation she will serve in the Army. Hopefully when her military obligation is completed, she will return to help the people of Georgetown County, where she was born and raised! With all of these students on board, our profession is in good hands!



Monday, we met for "class." There were multiple panels educating us on the issues that we would be lobbying. Several dentists demonstrated congressional meetings through role playing activities. Finally, we heard from both sides of the aisle. The cool thing about Lobby Day is that we aren't Democrat or Republican, we are the Tooth Party. We are seeking legislation to benefit our profession. Rep. Mike Simpson R-ID, who is one of 4 dentists in the House of Representatives, Senator Steve Daines R-MT, who has helped sponsor or co-sponsor many pro-dentistry bills over the years, and Tom Persico, Executive Director of the Democratic Congressional Campaign Committee, all addressed our group. After the long day of learning and preparing, our entire delegation went out to dinner for some great food and conversation at the Smith. The evening concluded at a rooftop overlooking the White House and the Washington Monument with the students.

Tuesday was THE day, our trip to Capitol Hill. Our delegation was able to meet with the staff of all SC Representatives – Senator Lindsay Graham and Senator Tim Scott; Representatives Jeff Duncan, Jim Clyburn, Joe Wilson, Tom Rice, Nancy Mace, Ralph Norman and William Timmons. All were very receptive to our issues which included Student Loan Debt; the Dental and Optometric Care Act, which addresses non covered services; trying to achieve a national Medicaid dental benefit; and, the Ensuring Lasting Smiles Act (ELSA), requiring insurance companies to continue to pay for additional surgeries for patients with dental anomalies, including cleft lip and palate patients. Having the MUSC students with us was pivotal to making our case for Student Loan Debt aid. Many of them will be graduating with close to \$400,000 in educational debt, and their personal stories were truly compelling. A few weeks after returning from Washington, we learned the House passed ELSA, so now it will move to the Senate. A huge victory!



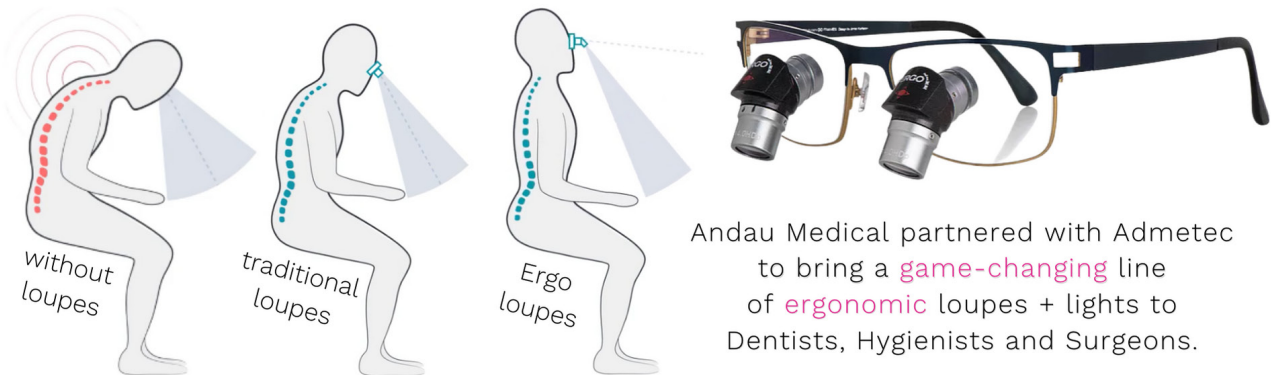

Award Categories:

George P. Hoffmann, Jr. - Distinguished Dentist Award

This award is the premier and most prestigious award presented by the South Carolina Dental Association. It is to honor a member or former member for years of outstanding service to the SCDA, the dental profession, and the community. Nominees must have practiced dentistry in South Carolina for a minimum of ten years.

Meritorious Achievement Award

The nominee must be a member in good standing of the SCDA who has demonstrated in recent years significant achievement in dentistry in the areas of professionalism, leadership, academics, research, or health care delivery.

James B Edwards Citizenship Award

The nominee must be a member in good standing of the SCDA who has served the citizens of South Carolina in a manner that reflects a positive image of dentistry. Areas of achievement include humanitarian and religious activities, civic affairs, community service, or cultural contributions.

New Dentist Award

The nominee must be a member in good standing of the SCDA who has been in practice ten years or less or who is under forty years of age. The nominee must have demonstrated leadership qualities through service to dentistry.

Dental Team Award

Team members in a private office. The nominee must be from an office of a SCDA member and nominated by an SCDA member. The criteria for evaluation include:

- The nominee demonstrates the he/she holds the profession of dentistry in the highest regard.
- The nominee has five or more years of experience in the dental field.
- The nominee promotes the interest and betterment of the profession through the team concept of dentistry.
- The nominee participates in community activities that bring credit to the dental profession.
- The nominee demonstrates enthusiasm for his/her work and creates innovative ideas about patient relations and managerial modifications that improve the delivery of patient care.

Special Recognition Award

The nominee may be any individual who deserves recognition for special achievement or an extraordinary deed related or unrelated to dentistry. This award provides for special circumstances that do not conform the other awards.

Do You Need More Than Just Travel Insurance These Days? (Hint: YES)

Despite the current geopolitical tensions in Europe, and the emergence of BA.2 (the newest Omicron variant) in the news, many people will nonetheless be heading out on spring and summer travel abroad. If there's one thing the pandemic taught us, it was the value of travel insurance, especially "Cancel For Any Reason" insurance (commonly known as CFAR) and medical coverage. But is additional travel protection necessary?



Air medical transport and travel security memberships have been receiving a lot of attention in the media lately, are they really worth the extra cost? For most travel experts, the answer is an emphatic "yes."

Travel Insurance Has Limitations

Travel insurance is important. The best will cover a good chunk of money back should you not be able (or feel safe enough) to go on the trip. It will cover trip interruption (extra hotel nights if you get delayed, or test positive for your return), medical expenses should you become ill or have an accident, and medical evacuation should you require medevac to the nearest hospital capable of treating you. But even with the best policies, that's likely where you'll stay.

You should always read the fine print in your travel insurance plan because the medical coverage is always limited to some extent. Medical treatment costs are capped at a certain dollar amount, transfer by air ambulance to a hospital at home ("repatriation") is typically only done if "medically necessary", and "hospital of choice" is frequently misread as "hospital of choice at home" (but really only means hospital of choice in the city you're currently in).

Membership in a medical transport program like Medjet is affordable, and gives travelers greater control over where they receive medical care. Getting moved to a hospital at home becomes your choice, not left up to an insurance company to determine whether the current facility is "adequate" or not, and whether moving you is "medically necessary". As medical professionals, you also understand the importance of getting back into a system of care you trust, and back under the higher limits of your own health insurance coverage.

Should you incur treatment costs above covered limits, or desire services not covered, the financial responsibility lies with you alone. A serious injury can quickly turn into a serious out-of-pocket bill, and a single medical transport to get moved home can range from \$30,000 (domestic) to \$180,000 (international).

Compared to a \$99 Medjet membership, you begin to see why so many experts recommend this additional protection.

Security Threats Abroad

While tensions in Europe obviously have travelers nervous, violent crime is also on the rise globally. The pandemic stressed many economies, but perhaps the hardest hit were countries whose economies relied heavily on tourism. Crime has always been present in tourist destinations, but since the pandemic the U.S. Department of State's Travel Advisory system has shown elevated security warnings for many areas typically thought of as "very safe".

It's Not Just For "Dangerous" Travel

Travelers often dismiss the idea of getting a supplemental travel protection because they aren't planning excursions like cage diving with sharks or participating in events like Spain's annual Running With the Bulls. The extra protection doesn't seem necessary if they're just sightseeing. In reality, unexpected injuries and emergencies can happen at any time, and to anyone, not just people who are going on potentially "dangerous excursions" or participating in extreme sports or activities. If those types of activities ARE in your travel agenda, again, read the limitations of your insurance policy because many won't cover injuries sustained while doing them. Medjet has no "adventure travel" exclusions (and no pre-existing condition exclusions under age 75).

Accidents Happen Close To Home Too

An added bonus of being an annual Medjet member is that it covers domestic travel as well, any time you venture more than 150 miles from home. Most of our members buy our protection for the "big international trip" but many of our transports each year end up being for accidents like a slip and fall at a wedding, or a serious illness landing a member in a hospital just a few states away. Right now, we're inundated with spring skiing accidents and summer will likely bring its typical heavy load of downed motorcycle transports. People don't think about our program for domestic travel because most health insurance covers emergency treatment in other states. But it can be just as unsettling to be stuck in an unfamiliar hospital a few states away as it is to be stuck in one halfway around the world.

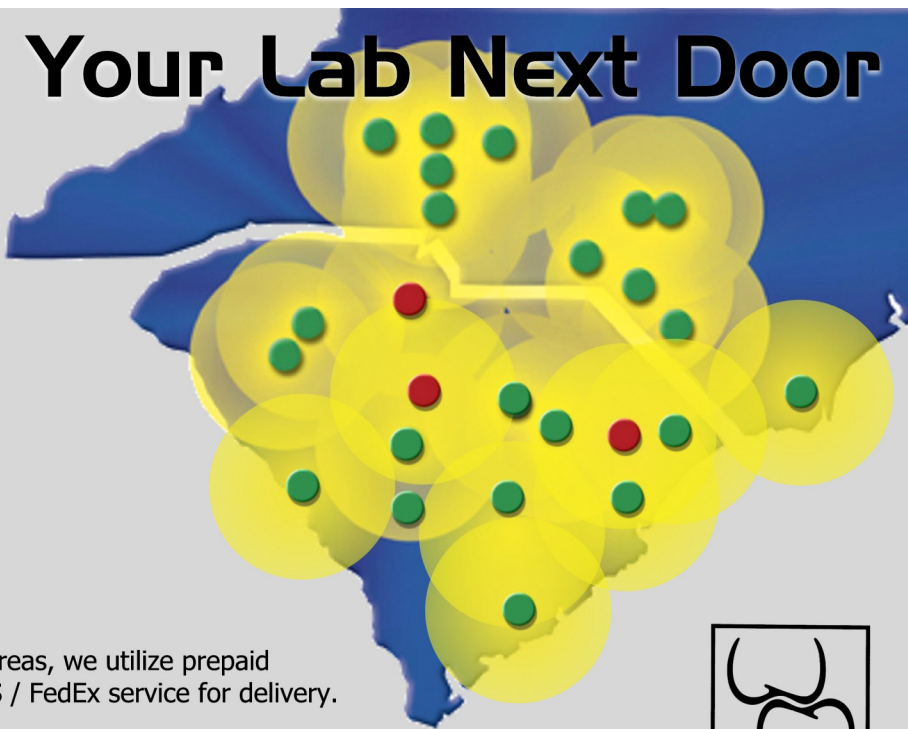

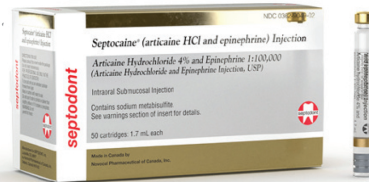

Edwards College of Dental Medicine family. Our students take advantage of every opportunity to lead, innovate and inspire their peers and the generation to follow.

In March, our students in the American Student Dental Association joined Dr. Nick Papadea, SCDA President, Dr. Hal Fair and Dr. David Watson at ASDA Lobby Day in Washington, D.C. The national agenda addressed the REDI act regarding student debt, the ELSA act, Medicare and the DOC act. I applaud our students for working to address the critical issue of student debt for the next generation. We are also proud of Mr. Sammy Huynh, D3 student, who was recently elected national vice president of ASDA.

Students in our American Academy of Developmental Medicine and Dentistry group volunteered their time and raised funds for worthy causes that benefit patients who use our special needs clinic, including the Spread the Word, Positive Exposure and Special Olympics South Carolina.

The Omicron Kappa Upsilon chapter at MUSC celebrated its fiftieth convocation banquet on April 1. After a two-year hiatus due to the pandemic, members welcomed student, resident and faculty inductees. New student members are selected from the top 12% of their class for high scholarship and character, while honorary members and faculty are nominated by OKU faculty.

Over a dozen students volunteered for our free pediatric dental screening day, which served 48 children. The day was the final event in our clinic's National Children's Dental Health Month series, aimed at connecting young patients with a dental home for life.

In our facilities alignment we are looking forward to the completion of the dental clinic at the West Ashley Medical Pavilion by Aug. 1, 2022. We are also exploring collaborations with primary healthcare across the state, which would offer integration of oral health with general health. We wish interoperability of our electronic health record with that of the health system.

More highlights from this spring include Homecoming Weekend, at which we saw many of our alumni for an oyster roast and continuing education. We welcomed five new full-time faculty members this semester: Dr. Sonali Rathore in oral radiology, Dr. Tina Woods and Dr. Angela Yoon in oral pathology, Dr. Fabio Riazante in Digital Dentistry and Dr. Hannah Rustin in pediatric dentistry.

Finally, please join me in congratulating the James B. Edwards College of Dental Medicine class of 2022, many of whom will be joining you in practice across South Carolina very soon.
